TUESDAY BLOCK 1

DRAMA

Lights, Camera, Action! If you like being a star, you will enjoy this elective. We will learn the basics of acting from performing on the stage to what goes on behind the curtains.

EXPLORING PHOTOGRAPHY

What makes a great picture? Discover the wide range of picture opportunities available, as well as different techniques you can use to create unusual compositions and special effects. Join us and learn the basic rules of composition as well as many professional tips!

GARDENING
